Coram Voice (Lincolnshire) Independent Visitors – East Lindsey

Independent Visitors are volunteers who befriend and spend time with a child or young person within Local Authority care. Our volunteers enjoy the challenge of building a lasting friendship and the children benefit greatly from a consistent, fun relationship with someone outside the care system.

The Bubble Car Museum Tea Room Assistant – Coningsby

Volunteers are required to serve visitors with pots of tea and cakes. There will also be washing up duties.

Museum Maintenance Volunteer – Coningsby

A team of volunteers get together every Thursday during the closed season (November to March) to change displays, do maintenance work including painting and decorating to ensure the museum is as inviting as it can be for the new visitor season.

Museum Counter Assistant – Coningsby

Volunteers are required to serve visitors as they come into the Museum, take money and sell items as required from the Museum stock of gifts.

Schoolreaders Schoolreader in Local Primary School – East Lindsey

Schoolreaders recruit volunteers and match them to primary schools where they give free one-to-one reading sessions. Our aim is to make sure that every child can read well by the time they move to secondary school at the age of 11. Our volunteers currently listen to 12,500 children read every week across England.
